


Defence Strategic Trajectory

Budget Impact On Defence Industry

- Foreign ownership
- Export opportunities
- Reduction of staff
- Loss of capability in certain areas
- Loss of capable staff in SANDF



Strategic Independence

- Self reliance on performance of key functions for an extended period.
 - Support, maintain & repair critical products and systems
 - Manufacture critical modules
 - Operational research
 - Perform Test and Evaluation
 - R&D that is in line with SANDF Requirements





Sovereign Capability

- Full national control of capabilities identified as vital to national security.
 - Integration & support of systems
 - Design, develop & support algorithms and S/W
 - Design, develop, manufacture & support H/W
 - Control by SOE or RSA owned company





Types Of Defence Companies

- South African Defence Company
 - Single source
- Partially RSA Owned Defence Company
 - When necessary
- South African Based Company
 - With special permission
- Foreign controlled defence company
 - Never
- Foreign Company
 - Never





Role Of Defence Industry

- Provide high quality products on time and at a reasonable cost
- Support products with quick response times for 20 to 30 years
- Explore external markets especially in Africa
- Ensure continuity of capability by transferring skills to young engineering graduates.
- Look for manufacturing opportunities of foreign products.

- Cabinet approved on 17 March 2014
- Parliamentary approval expected in mid August 2014
- Extra R11.4b for 2014/15
- An additional R11.2b in 2015/16
